TERMS AND CONDITIONS

“Bank More, Score More”

The terms and conditions of the Promotion are as follows:

Campaign:

- 1- Standard Chartered Bank's "Bank more, Score More" campaign begins on **01st April 2021** and ends on **April 30th, 2021**.
- 2- To participate in the promotion, all participants will need to register to the dedicated page of the promotion on sc.com/ci. Once done, they will be deemed to have accepted, without exclusion, these terms and conditions, and declare to be bound by them.
- 3- These campaign terms and conditions must be jointly read with the Standard Chartered Bank's banking terms and conditions

Eligibility

- The Promotion is opened to all retail banking new and existing clients of Standard Chartered Bank Côte d'Ivoire ("SCB" or "SCB CDI"), aged 18 or over, holding current and saving account in local currency opened via SC Mobile app.
- All the customers who opened their account manually should sign-up to SC Mobile (CDI) before and/or during the promotion period to be eligible to the promotion.
- All Standard Chartered Bank's customers who maintain their accounts and debit cards in accordance with the bank's rules without any breach of the subscribed banking product's terms and conditions throughout the campaign period.
- Companies and non-governmental organisations are not eligible for this promotion.
- All account holders whose accounts have been suspended/closed for any reason during the campaign period are not eligible
- All customers who ticked the option not to be contacted for any marketing campaign (DnD) are not eligible
